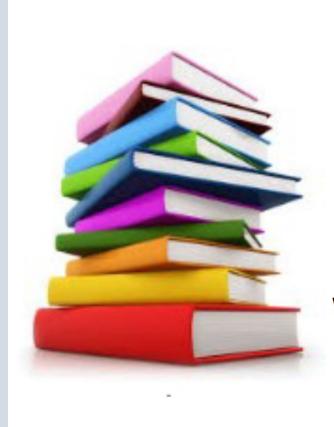

Orders can be placed via the app or website

- 1. Download app from itunes and google play search for "Bakerymade" (all one word)
- 2. Enter "Sign In" & register as a customer.
- 3. "View Account" & add your address details.
- 4. Select your products to order
- 5. School, class, name etc entered at product
- 6.At check out select payment option credit card or paypal (paypal via website only)
- 7. Order history to review orders

Troubleshooting Notes:

As a standard practice with the app sign out after using each week.

If you stay logged on the app will time out but a glitch makes it appear you are still logged on.

If you process an order and your address does not appear automatically this is an indicator you have timed out. You should then sign out and back in again

On the app you may receive a message after entering credit card details of expiry date not valid just enter the ok as it will be fine

When paying by paypal on the website you will be directed back to the website after completing payment make sure you then confirm your order otherwise it will not be processed

To check your order has gone through you can check your order history

Any problems with anything contact via text or call my mobile as the quickest way to reply


